DO YOU KNOW WHERE ... ?

We say: EX1: Where has Tom gone? but EX3: What time is it? but EX4: Who are those people? EX5: Where can I find Louise? EX6: How much will it cost? Be careful with do/does/did questions. We say: What time **does the film** start? • EX7: **EX8:**

or ... whether anybody saw me.

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EX2: Do you know where Tom has gone? (not has Tom gone) When the question (Where has Tom gone?) is part of a longer sentence (Do you know ... ? / I don't know ... / Can you tell me ... ? etc.), the word order changes. We say:

- Do you know what time it is? I don't know who those people are. Can you tell me where I can find Louise? Do you have any idea how much it will cost?
- but Do you know what time the film starts? (not does the film start)
- What do you mean? Please explain what you mean.
- EX9: Why did she leave early? I wonder why she left early.
- Use if or whether where there is no other question word (what, why etc.): EX10: Did anybody see you? but I don't know if anybody saw me.



Question 2 HE ASKED ME WHERE ...

The same changes in word order happen in questions in reported speech. Compare: The police officer said to us 'Where are you going?' EX11: direct The police officer asked us where we were going. reported Clare asked 'What time do the shops close?' direct EX12: Clare wanted to know what time the shops closed. reported In reported speech the verb usually changes to the past (were, closed etc.) Study these examples. You had a job interview and the interviewer asked you these questions:
