Unit 55 – Verb (+ object) + to ... (I want you to ...)





#### VERB + OBJECT + TO ...

Verb to...

want
expect to go
ask to be
help to work
would like etc.
would prefer

EX1A: We **expected to be** late. EX2A: Would you **like to go** now? EX3:A He doesn't **want to know**.

Verbobjectto ...wantto goexpectto goasksomeoneto behelpsomebodyto workwould likeetc.would prefer

EX1B: We expected Dan to be late.

EX2B: Would you like me to go now?

EX3B: He doesn't want anybody to know.

#### We do NOT usually say 'want that':

EX4: Do you want me to come with you? (not want that I come)

You can use help with or without to. You can say:

EX5: Can you help me to move this table? or Can you help me move this table?

#### VERB + OBJECT + TO ...

We use these verbs with this structure:

object	to
	togo
someone	to be
somebody	to work
	etc.
	someone

- EX6: It's not a nice hotel. I wouldn't advise you to stay there.
- EX7: Can you remind me to call Sam tomorrow?
- EX8: Joe said the switch was dangerous and warned me not to touch it.
- EX9: I didn't move the piano by myself. I got somebody to help me.
- EX10: Who taught you to drive?
- EX11: They don't allow people to park in front of the building.
  In these examples, the verb is passive (I was warned / we are allowed etc.):
  - EX12: I was warned not to touch the switch.
  - EX13: Are we allowed to park here?

We do not use suggest with to ...:

EX14: Jane suggested that I ask you for advice.
 (not Jane suggested me to ask)

### MAKE / LET SOMEBODY DO SOMETHING

We say 'make somebody do something', 'let somebody do something' (without to):

- EX15: I made him promise that he wouldn't tell anybody what happened.
   (not made him to promise)
- EX16: Hot weather makes me feel tired. (= causes me to feel tired)
- EX17: Her parents wouldn't let her go out alone. (= wouldn't allow her to go out)
- EX18: Let me carry your bag for you.

We say 'make somebody do', but in the passive we say '(be) made to do' (with to):

EX19: We were made to wait for two hours. (= They made us wait ...)
