Unit 62 – Verb + preposition + -ing (succeed in -ing / insist on -ing etc.)

VERB + PREPOSITION + -ING

We use some verbs + preposition + object. For example:

verb + preposition + object

EX1: about the problem.

If the object is another verb, we use -ing:

	verb	preposition	-ing
EX3:	We talked	about	going to South America.
EX4:	You should apologize	for	not telling the truth.



VERB + PREPOSITION + -ING

You can use these verbs in the same way:

He doesn't approve EX5: approve of swearing. EX6: decide against moving to London. We have decided against asking them for money. wouldn't dream EX7: dream of of going out tonight. EX8: feel like don't feel like paying for the meal. EX9: insist on They insisted on EX10: look forward to Are you looking forward going away? to Has Paul succeeded EX11: succeed in finding a job yet?

You can also say 'approve of somebody doing something', 'look forward to somebody doing something' etc.

- EX14: We are all looking forward to Andy coming home next week.

VERB + OBJECT + PREPOSITION + -ING

Some verbs can have the structure verb + object + preposition + -ing. For example:

verb + object + preposition + -ing

■ EX15:	accuse	of
---------	--------	----

EX16: congratulate ... on

EX17: prevent ... from

EX18: stop... from

EX19: suspect ... of

EX20: thank ... for

He accused	me	of	telling lies.
We congratulated	Lisa	on	winning the first prize.
What prevented	you	from	coming to see us?
The rain didn't stop	us	from	enjoying our holiday.
Nobody suspected	the general	of	being a spy.
I thanked	everyone	for	helping me.



VERB + OBJECT + PREPOSITION + -ING

You can say 'stop somebody doing' or 'stop somebody from doing':

EX21: You can't stop me doing what I want. or You can't stop me from doing ...

Note this example with not -ing:

EX22: He accused me of not telling the truth.

Some of these verbs are often used in the passive. For example:

- EX23: We were accused of telling lies. (or ... accused of lying.)
- EX24: The general was suspected of being a spy.

Note that we say 'apologize to somebody for ...':

EX25: I apologized to them for keeping them waiting. (not I apologized them)
