Jack is watching television. He is not playing the guitar.

But Jack has a guitar. He often plays it and he plays very well.

Jack plays the guitar, but he is not playing the guitar now.

- EX1: Is he playing the guitar? No, he isn't. (present continuous)
- EX2: Does he play the guitar? Yes, he does. (present simple)

past

l'm doing
now future

### Present continuous (I am doing) = now, at the time of speaking:

- EX3: Please be quiet. I'm working. (not I work)
- EX4: Tom is having a shower at the moment. (not Tom has)
- EX5: Take an umbrella with you. It's raining.
- EX6: You can turn off the television. I'm not watching it.
- EX7: Why are you under the table? What are you doing?

Past Now Future

Present simple (I do) = in general, all the time or sometimes

- EX8: I work every day from 9 o'clock to 5.30.
- EX9: Tom has a shower every morning.
- EX10: It rains a lot in winter.
- EX11: I don't watch TV very often.
- EX12: What do you usually do at weekends?

#### NON-PROGRESSIVE VERBS

D

We do not use these verbs in the present continuous (I am -ing):

Like Want Know Understand Remember

Prefer need Mean Believe Forget

Use only the present simple with these verbs (I want / do you like? etc.):

- EX13: I'm tired. I want to go home. (not I'm wanting)
- EX14: 'Do you know that girl?' 'Yes, but I don't remember her name.'
- EX15: I don't understand. What do you mean?
