

am/is (present)	-> was (past)	are (present)	→ were (past)
I am tired. (now)	I was tired last night.	You are late. (now)	You were late yesterday.
Where is Kate? (now)	Where was Kate yesterday?	They aren't here. (now)	They weren't here last Sunday.
The weather is good today.	The weather was good last week.
