- Ex1: What time is it?
- Ex2: It's half past ten.
- Ex3: It's late.
- Ex4: It's time to go home.



- Ex5: What day is it?
- Ex6: It's Thursday.
- Ex7: It's 16 March.
- Ex8: It was my birthday yesterday.








- EX9: It's three kilometers from our house to the city center.
- EX10: How far is it from New York to Los Angeles?
- EX11: It's a long way from here to the station.
- EX12: We can walk home. It isn't far

We use far in questions (is it far?) and negatives (it isn't far).

In positive sentences, we use a long way (it's a long way).



- EX13: It's raining. It isn't raining. Is it snowing?
- EX14: It rains a lot here. It didn't rain yesterday. Does it snow very often?
- EX15: It's warm/hot/cold/fine/cloudy/windy/sunny/foggy/dark etc.
- EX16: It's a nice day today.

Compare it and there:

- EX17: It rains a lot in winter.
- EX18: There is a lot of rain in winter.
- EX19: It was very windy.
- EX20: There was a strong wind yesterday.
