

CÂU HỎI VỚI WHO / WHAT

In these questions, who/what is the subject:

- Ex1: Who lives in this house? (= somebody lives in it who?) (not Who does live?)
- Ex2: What happened? (= something happened what?) (not What did happen?)
- Ex3: What's happening? (What's = What is)
- Ex4: Who's got my key? (Who's = Who has)

In these questions, who/what is the object:

- Ex5: Who did you meet yesterday? (= you met somebody who?)
- Ex6: What did Paul say? (= Paul said something what?)
- Ex7: Who are you phoning?
- Ex8: What was Silvia wearing?

Compare:

- Ex9: George likes oranges. → Who likes oranges? George.
 What does George like? Oranges.
- Ex10: Jane won a new car. → Who won a new car? Jane.
 What did Jane win? A new car.

Who saw you? Who did you see (question 2)

CÁCH DÙNG WHO / WHAT

Use who for people (somebody). Use what for things, ideas etc. (something):

- Ex11: Who is your favorite singer?
- Ex12: What is your favorite song?
