ĐỘNG TỪ THEO SAU BỞI TO - INFINITIVE

want	plan	decide	try	
hope	expect	offer	forget	+ to (to do / to work / to be etc.)
need	promise	refuse	learn	

- Ex1: What do you want to do this evening?
- Ex2: It's not very late. We don't need to go home yet.
- Ex3: Tina has decided to sell her car.
- Ex4: You forgot to switch off the light when you went out.
- Ex5: My brother is learning to drive.
- Ex6: I tried to read my book, but I was too tired.



ĐỘNG TỪ THEO SAU BỞI V-ING

enjoy stop mind finish suggest

+ -ing (doing / working / being etc)

- Ex7: I enjoy dancing. (not enjoy to dance)
- Ex8: I don't mind getting up early.
- Ex9: Has it stopped raining?
- Ex10: Sonia suggested going to the cinema.





ĐỘNG TỪ THEO SAU BỞI V–ING HOẶC TO -INFINITIVE

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like love start continue + -ing (doing etc) or to ... (to do etc.)
prefer hate begin
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- Ex11: Do you like getting up early? or Do you like to get up early?
- Ex12: I prefer travelling by car. or I prefer to travel by car.
- Ex13: Anna loves dancing, or Anna loves to dance.
- Ex14: I hate being late, or I hate to be late.
- Ex15: It started raining, or It started to rain.



D CÁCH DÙNG "WOULD LIKE TO ..."

would like would love would prefer would hate + to ... (to do / to work / to be etc.)

- Ex16: Amy would like to meet you.
- Ex17: I'd love to go to Australia. (I'd = I would)
- Ex18: 'Would you like to sit down?' 'No, I'd prefer to stand, thank you.'
- Ex19: I like this apartment. I wouldn't like to move.
- E20: I live in a small village. I'd hate to live in a big city.
