




#### A GIỚI THIỆU CẤU TRÚC "I WANT YOU TO..."

We say:	ant	you somebody Sarah	to do something
---------	-----	--------------------------	-----------------

- Ex1: I want you to be happy. (not I want that you are happy)
- Ex2: They didn't want anybody to know their secret.
- Ex3: Do you want me to lend you some money?

We use would like in the same way:

Ex4: Would you like me to lend you some money?



#### CÂU TRÚC "S + VERB + SOMEBODY + TO..."

We also use this structure with:

ask	Ex5:	Sue	asked	a friend	to lend	her some money.
tell	Ex6:		told	you	to be	careful.
advise	Ex7:	What do you	advise	me	to do?	
expect	Ex8:	I didn't	expect	them	to be	here.
persuade	Ex9:	We	persuaded	Gary	to come	with us.
teach	Ex10:		am teaching	my brother	to swim.	



#### C CẤU TRÚC "I TOLD YOU TO.../ I TOLD YOU NOT TO..."



-> Jane told me to wait for her.

-> Paul told Sue not to wait for him.



#### ĐỘNG TỪ "MAKE" VÀ "LET"

After make and let, we do not use to:

- Ex11: He's very funny. He makes me laugh. (not makes me to laugh)
- Ex12: At school our teacher made us work very hard.
- Ex13: I didn't have my phone with me, so Sue let me use hers. (not let me to use)

You can say Let's ... (= Let us) when you want people to do things with you:

- Ex14: Come on! Let's dance.
- Ex15: 'Do you want to go out tonight?' 'No, I'm tired. Let's stay at home.'
