# I want you to... I told you to...

## A GIỚI THIỆU CẤU TRÚC “I WANT YOU TO...”



The woman wants to go.  
The man doesn't want the woman to go.  
He wants her to stay.

We say:

I want	you somebody Sarah	to do something
--------	--------------------------	-----------------

- Ex1: I want **you to be** happy. (not I want that you are happy)
- Ex2: They didn't want **anybody to know** their secret.
- Ex3: Do you want **me to lend** you some money?

We use **would like** in the same way:

- Ex4: **Would you like me to lend** you some money?



# I want you to... I told you to...

## B CẤU TRÚC “ S + VERB + SOMEBODY + TO...”

We also use this structure with:

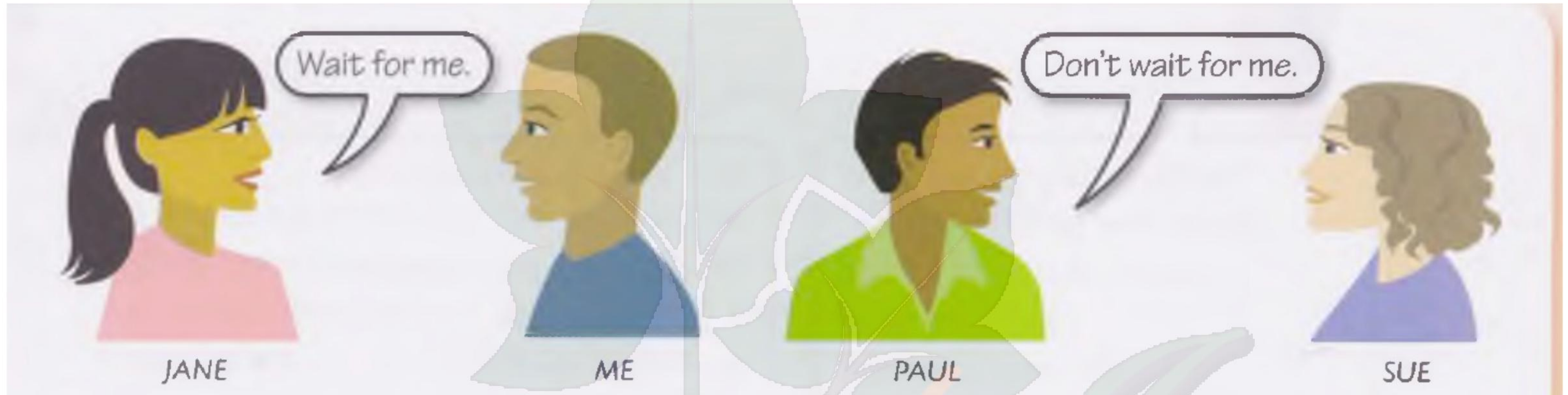
ask  
tell  
advise  
expect  
persuade  
teach

		verb.	+ somebody	+ to ...	
Ex5:	Sue	<b>asked</b>	a friend	<b>to lend</b>	her some money.
Ex6:	I	<b>told</b>	you	<b>to be</b>	careful.
Ex7:	What do you	<b>advise</b>	me	<b>to do?</b>	
Ex8:	I didn't	<b>expect</b>	them	<b>to be</b>	here.
Ex9:	We	<b>persuaded</b>	Gary	<b>to come</b>	with us.
Ex10:	I	<b>am teaching</b>	my brother	<b>to swim.</b>	



# I want you to... I told you to...

## C CẤU TRÚC “I TOLD YOU TO.../ I TOLD YOU NOT TO...”



—> Jane **told me to wait** for her.

—> Paul **told Sue not to wait** for him.



# I want you to... I told you to...

## D ĐỘNG TỪ "MAKE" VÀ "LET"

After **make** and **let**, we do not use **to**:

- Ex11: He's very funny. He **makes** me **laugh**. (not makes me to laugh)
- Ex12: At school our teacher **made** us **work** very hard.
- Ex13: I didn't have my phone with me, so Sue **let** me **use** hers. (not let me to use)

You can say **Let's ... (= Let us)** when you want people to do things with you:

- Ex14: Come on! **Let's dance**.
- Ex15: 'Do you want to go out tonight?' 'No, I'm tired. **Let's stay** at home.'

Let's ... → **Unit 35**    He told me that ... → **Unit 50**
