“TO...” ĐIỂN TẢ MỤC ĐÍCH

Paula wanted a newspaper, so she went to the shop.

Why did she go to the shop?

To get a newspaper.

She went to the shop to get a newspaper.

to ... (to get / to see etc.) tells us why a person does something:

- Ex1: 'Why are you going out?' **To buy** some food.'
- Ex2: Catherine went to the station **to meet** her friend.
- Ex3: Sue turned on the television **to watch** the news.
- Ex4: I'd like to go to Spain **to learn** Spanish.

money/time to (do something):

- Ex5: We need some **money to buy** food.
- Ex6: I haven't got **time to watch** television.

B SỰ KHÁC NHAU GIỮA “TO” VÀ “FOR” KHI ĐIỂN TẢ MỤC ĐÍCH

to + verb

(to get / to see etc.)

- Ex7A: I went to the shop **to get** a newspaper.
(not for get)
- Ex8A: They're going to Brazil **to see** their friends.
- Ex9A: We need some money **to buy** food.

for + noun

(for a newspaper / for food etc.)

- Ex7B: I went to the shop **for a newspaper**.
- Ex8B: They're going to Brazil **for a holiday**.
- Ex9B: We need some money **for food**.

C PHÂN BIỆT “WAIT FOR”, “WAIT TO DO STH” VÀ “WAIT FOR SB/STH TO DO STH

wait for ...

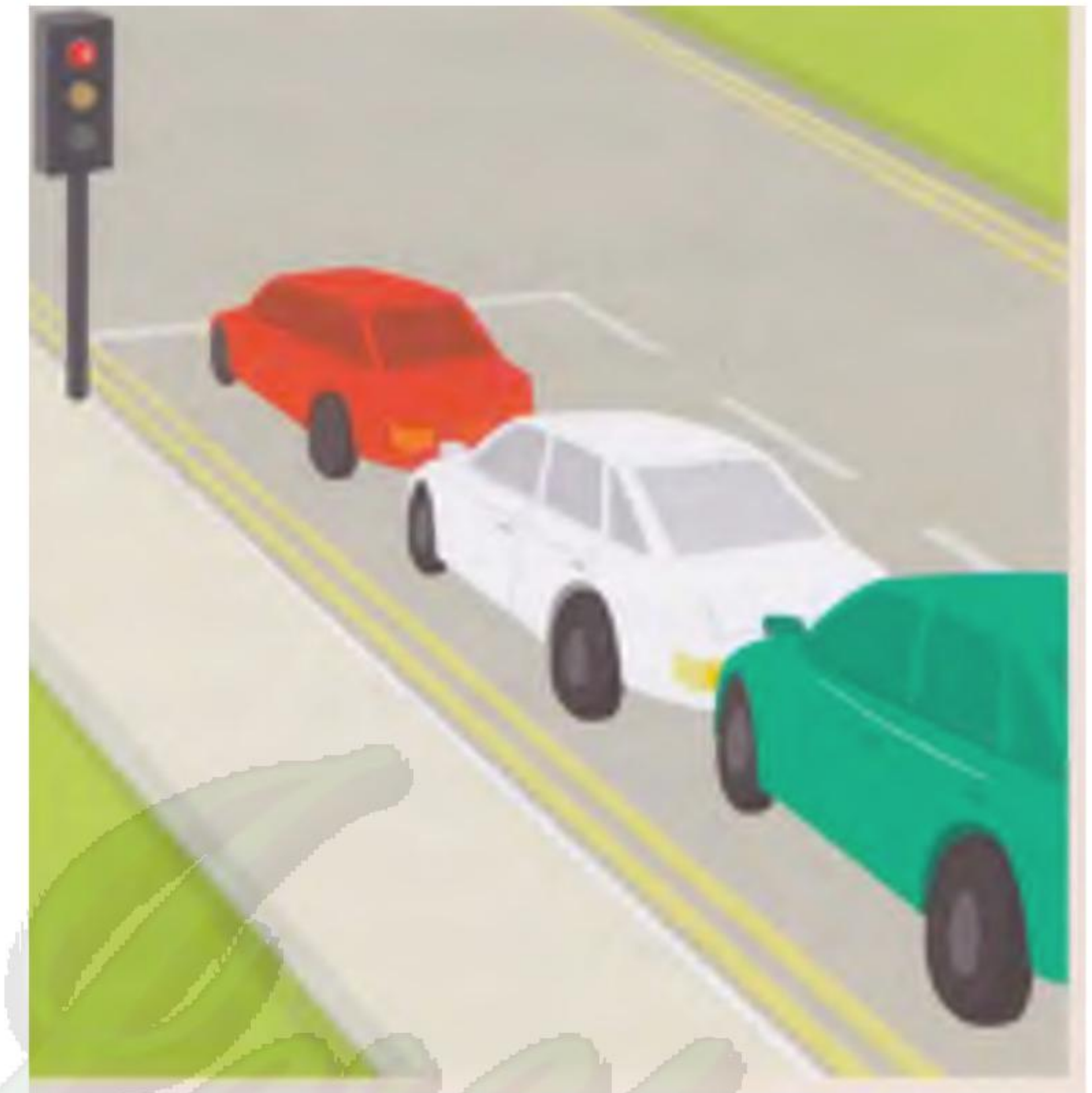
- Ex10: Please **wait for** me.
- Ex11: Are you **waiting for** the bus?

wait to (do something):

- Ex12: Hurry up! I'm **waiting to go**.
- Ex13: Are you **waiting to see** the doctor?

wait for (somebody/something) to ...

- Ex14: The lights are red. You have to **wait for them to change**.
- Ex15: Are you **waiting for the doctor to come**?



They're **waiting for the lights to change**.

go to ... and go for ... → **Unit 55** something to eat / nothing to do etc. → **Unit 79**
enough + to/for ... → **Unit 91** too + to/for ... → **Unit 92**
