





- Ex2: I don't want these books. You can have them.
- Ex3: Kate never drinks milk. She doesn't like it
- Ex4: I never go to parties. I don't like them.

#### ĐẠI TỪ LÀM TÚC TỪ THEO SAU GIỚI TỪ

We use me/her/them etc. (object) after a preposition (for/to/with etc):

- Ex5: This letter isn't for me. It's for you.
- Ex6: Who is that woman? Why are you looking at her?
- Ex7: We're going to the cinema. Do you want to come with us?
- Ex8: Sue and Kevin are going to the cinema. Do you want to go with them?
- Ex9: 'Where's the newspaper?' 'You're sitting on it.'

#### give it/them to ...

- Ex10: I want that book. Please give it to me.
- Ex11: Robert needs these books. Can you give them to him, please?
