



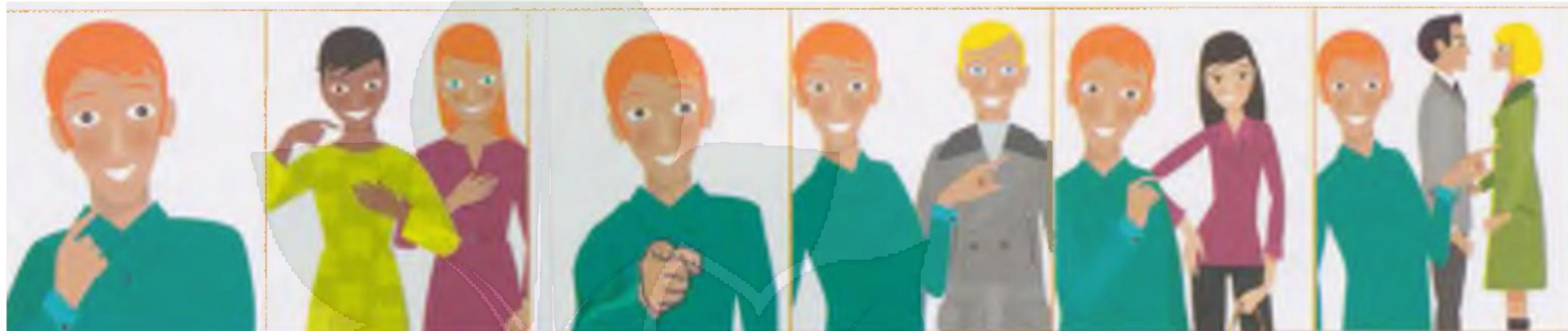

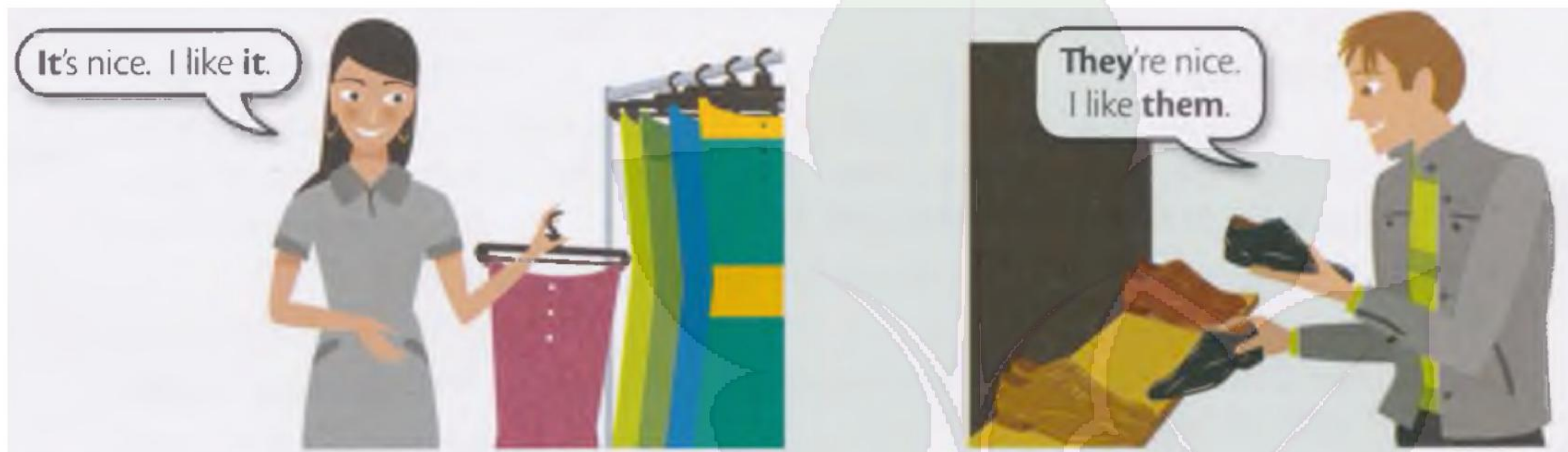

- Ex1: I don't want **this book**. You can have **it**.
- Ex2: I don't want **these books**. You can have **them**.
- Ex3: Kate never drinks **milk**. She doesn't like **it**
- Ex4: I never go to **parties**. I don't like **them**.

I/me he/him they/them etc.

C ĐẠİ TỪ' LÀM TÚC TỪ' THEO SAU GIÓI TỪ'

We use **me/her/them** etc. (object) after a preposition (**for/to/with** etc):

- Ex5: This letter isn't **for me**. It's **for you**.
- Ex6: Who is that woman? Why are you looking **at her**?
- Ex7: We're going to the cinema. Do you want to come **with us**?
- Ex8: Sue and Kevin are going to the cinema. Do you want to go **with them**?
- Ex9: 'Where's the newspaper?' 'You're sitting **on it**.'

give it/them to ...

- Ex10: I want that book. Please give **it to me**.
- Ex11: Robert needs these books. Can you give **them to him**, please?

my/his/their etc. → **Unit 60** Give me that book / Give it to me → **Unit 96**
