- Ex1: 'Do **you** know that man?' 'Yes, I know **him**, but I can't remember **his name**.'
- Ex2: **She** was very pleased because **we** invited **her** to stay with **us** at **our house**.
- Ex3: A: Where are the children? Have **you** seen them?
B: Yes, **they** are playing with **their friends** in the park.
- Ex4: That's **my pen**. Can **you** give it to me, please?
- Ex5: Is this **your umbrella**?' No, it's **yours**.'
- Ex6: **He** didn't have an umbrella, so she gave him hers. (= she gave her umbrella to him)
- Ex7: I'm going out with a friend of **mine** this evening. (not a friend of me)
