

- a ... = one thing or person:
- Ex1: Rachel works in a bank. (not in bank)
- Ex2: Can I ask a question? (not ask question)
- Ex3: I don't have a job at the moment.
- Ex4: There's a woman at the bus stop.



MẠO TÙ "AN"

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an (not a) before a/e/i/o/u:
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- Ex5: Do you want an apple or a banana?
- Ex6: I'm going to buy a hat and an umbrella.
- Ex7: There was an interesting program on TV last night.

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an hour (h is not pronounced: an our)
but
a university (pronounced university)
a European country (pronounced yuropean)
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another (= an + other) is one word:

Ex8: Can I have another cup of coffee?


CÁCH DÙNG MẠO TỪ "A" VÀ "AN"

We use a/an ... when we say what a thing or a person is. For example:

- Ex9: The sun is a star.
- Ex10: Football is a game.
- Ex11: Dallas is a city in Texas.
- Ex12: A mouse is an animal. It's a small animal.
- Ex13: Joe is a very nice person.

We use a/an ... for jobs etc.:

- Ex14: A: What's your job?
 - B: I'm a dentist. (not I'm dentist)
- Ex15: 'What does Mark do?' 'He's
 an engineer.'
- Ex16: Would you like to be a teacher?
- Ex17: Beethoven was a composer.
- Ex18: Picasso was a famous painter.
- Ex19: Are you a student?
