#### A ĐỐI VỚI LỤC ĐỊA, QUỐC GIA, BANG, ĐẢO, THÀNH PHỐ,...

In general we do not use the with names of places:

- Ex1: France is a very large country. (not the France)
- Ex2: Cairo is the capital of Egypt.
- Ex3: Corsica is an island in the Mediterranean.
- Ex4: Peru is in South America.



- the Czech Republic
- the United States of America (the USA)
- the United Kingdom (the UK)







B ĐốI VỚI QUỐC GIA, ĐẢO, ...Ở DẠNG SỐ NHIỀU

the -s (plural names)

We use the with plural names of countries/islands/mountains:

the Netherlands

the Philippines

the Canary Islands

the Alps







### ĐốI VỚI ĐẠI DƯƠNG, BIỂN, SÔNG, KÊNH ĐÀO

We use the with names of oceans/seas/rivers/canals:

the Atlantic (Ocean) the (River) Nile the Mediterranean (Sea)
the Suez Canal

the Amazon the Black Sea







#### ĐốI VỚI NƠI CHỐN TRONG THÀNH PHỐ

Places in towns (streets, buildings etc.)
In general we do not use **the** with names of streets, squares etc.:

- Ex5: Kevin lives in Newton Street.
- Ex6: Where is Highfield Road, please?
- Ex7: Times Square is in New York.

We do not use the with names of airports, stations and many other important buildings:

Kennedy Airport Westminster Abbey

Victoria Station Edinburgh Castle

also Cambridge University, Harvard University etc.

But we use the with names of most hotels, museums, theatres and cinemas:

the Regent Hotel the National Theatre

the Science Museum the Odeon (cinema)

### E ĐỐI VỚI TÊN ĐỊA ĐIỂM CÓ CHỮ "OF"

We use the + names with ... of ...:

- the Museum of Modern Art
- the Great Wall of China
- the University of California
- the Tower of London

We say the north / the south / the east / the west (of . . .):

Ex8: I've been to the north of Italy, but not to the south.
