

this (singular) Do you like this picture? this these


these (plural)




this picture (= this picture here) these flowers (= these flowers here) that (singular)

CÁCH DÙNG "THIS / THAT / THESE / THOSE"

We use this/that/these/those with a noun (this picture / those girls etc) or without a noun:

- Ex1: This hotel is expensive, but it's very nice.
- Ex2: 'Who's that girl?' 'I don't know.'
- Ex3: Do you like these shoes? I bought them last week.
- Ex4: Those apples look nice. Can I have one?
- Ex5: This is a nice hotel, but it's very expensive.
- Ex6: 'Excuse me, is this your bag?' 'Oh yes, thank you.'
- Ex7: Who's that? (= Who is that person?)
- Ex8: Which shoes do you prefer these or those?

with a noun

without a noun

This / that / these / those



CÁC CÁCH DÙNG KHÁC CỦA "THAT"

that = something that has happened:

- Ex9: I'm sorry I forgot to phone you.' 'That's all right.'
- Ex10: That was a really nice meal. Thank you very much.

that = what somebody has just said:

- Ex11: 'You're a teacher, aren't you?' 'Yes, that's right.'
- Ex12: 'Martin has a new job.' 'Really? I didn't know that.'
- Ex13: I'm going on holiday next week.' 'Oh, that's nice.'

CÁC CÁCH DÙNG KHÁC CỦA "THAT"

We use this is ... and is that ...? on the phone:

Ex14: Hi Sarah, this is David.

(this = the speaker)

Ex15: Is that Sarah?


(that = the other person)

We use this is ... to introduce people:

Ex16: A: Ben, this is Chris.

B: Hello, Chris - nice to meet you.
