Some and any

A PHÂN BIỆT “SOME” VÀ “ANY”



Use **some** in positive sentences:

- Ex1A: I'm going to buy **some** clothes.
- Ex2A: There's **some** milk in the fridge.
- Ex3A: We made **some** mistakes.



Use **any** in negative sentences:

- Ex1B: I'm **not** going to buy any clothes.
- Ex2B: There **isn't** any milk in the fridge.
- Ex3B: We **didn't** make any mistakes.

Some and any

B “ANY” VÀ “SOME” TRONG CÂU HỎI

In most questions (but not all) we use **any** (not **some**):

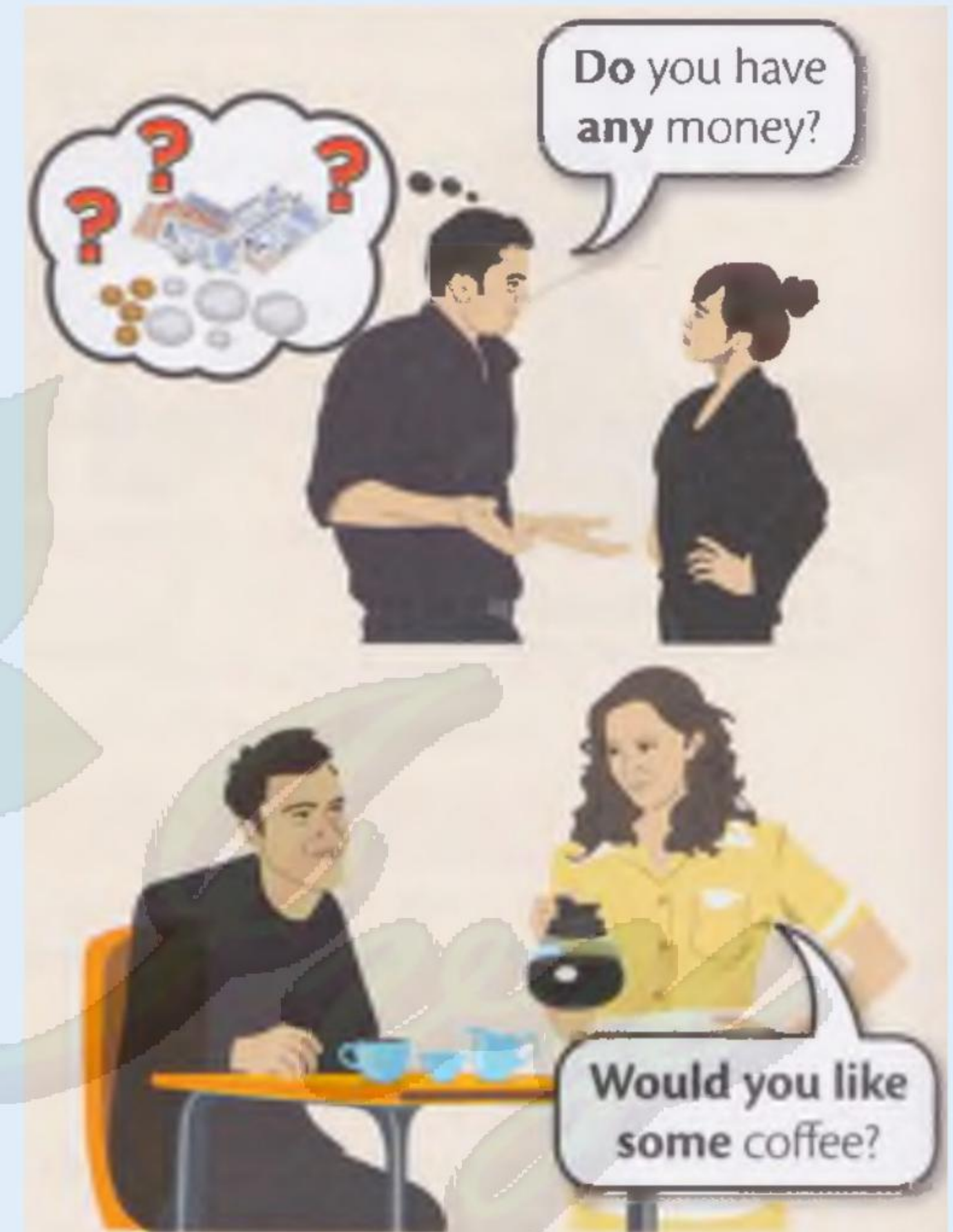
- Ex4: Is there **any** milk in the fridge?
- Ex5: Does he have **any** friends?
- Ex6: Do you need **any** help?

We normally use **some** (not **any**) when we offer things (**Would you like ...?**):

- Ex7: A: Would you like **some** coffee?
B: Yes, please.

or when we *ask for things* (**Can I have ...?** etc.):

- Ex8: A: Can I have **some** soup, please?
B: Yes. Help yourself.
- Ex9: A: Can you lend me **some** money?
B: Sure. How much do you need?



Some and any



C “SOME” VÀ “ANY” KHÔNG CÓ DANH TỪ THEO SAU

some and **any** without a noun

- Ex10: I didn't take any pictures, but Jessica took **some**. (= some pictures)
- Ex11: You can have some coffee, but I don't want **any**. (= any coffee)
- Ex12: I've just made some coffee. Would you like **some**? (= some coffee)
- Ex13: 'Where's your luggage?' 'I don't have **any**.' (= any luggage)
- Ex14: 'Are there any biscuits?' 'Yes, there are **some** in the kitchen.' (= some biscuits)

Some and any

D CÁCH DÙNG “SOMETHING, SOMEBODY, ANYTHING, ANYBODY”

something / somebody (or someone)

- Ex15A: She said **something**.
- Ex16A: I saw **somebody** (or **someone**).
- Ex17A: Would you like **something** to eat?
- Ex18A: **Somebody's** at the door.

anything / anybody (or anyone)

- Ex15B: She **didn't** say **anything**.
- Ex16B: I **didn't** see **anybody** (or **anyone**).
- Ex17B: Are you doing **anything** tonight?
- Ex18B: Where's Sue? Has **anybody** seen her?
