children/money/books etc. (in general):

- Ex1A: **Children** like playing.
(= *children in general*)
- Ex2A: **Money** isn't everything.
(= *money in general*)
- Ex3A: I enjoy reading **books**.
- Ex4A: Everybody needs **friends**.

the children / the money / these books etc :

- Ex1B: Where are **the children**?
(= *our children*)
- Ex2B: I want to buy a car, but I don't have **the money**. (= *the money for a car*)
- Ex3B: Have you read **these books**?
- Ex4B: I often go out with **my friends**.

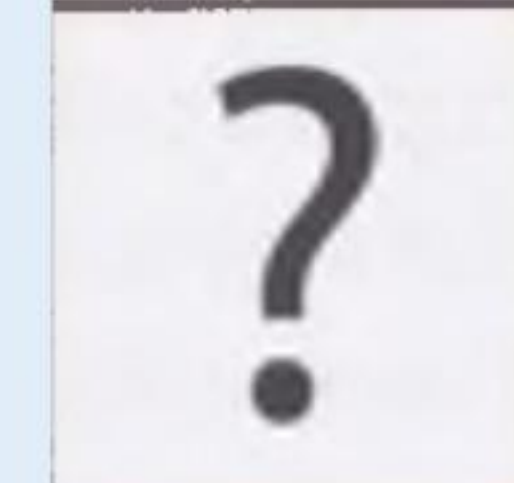

- Ex5A: **Most children** like playing. (= children in general)
- Ex6A: I don't want **any money**.
- Ex7A: **Some books** are better than others.
- Ex8A: He has **no friends**.
- Ex9: **All cities** have the same problems. (= cities in general)

- Ex5B: Most of the children at this school are under 11 years old.
- Ex6B: I don't want **any of this money**.
- Ex7B: **Some of these books** are very old.
- Ex8B: **None of my friends** live near me.

All, most, some, any, no-none

B PHÂN BIỆT MOST / MOST OF..., SOME / SOME OF..., ETC...

Do not use **of** in these sentences:

- Ex10: **Most people** drive too fast.
(not Most of people)
- Ex11: **Some birds** can't fly.
(not Some of birds)

You can say **all the ...** or **all of the ...** (with or without **of**):

- Ex12: **All the students** in our class passed the exam.
(or **All of the students . . .**)
- Ex13: Amy has lived in London **all her life**.
(or... **all of her life.**)

C CÁCH DÙNG “ALL OF IT / MOST OF THEM / NONE OF US, ETC.”

all	of	it
most		them
some		us
any		you

- Ex14: You can have **some of this cake**, but not **all of it**.
- Ex15: A: Do you know those people?
B: **Most of them**, but not **all of them**.
- Ex16: **Some of us** are going out tonight. Why don't you come with us?
- Ex17: I have a lot of books, but I haven't read **any of them**.
- Ex18: 'How many of these books have you read?' '**None of them**.'

the...(children / the children etc) → **Unit 72**
