A VỊ TRÍ CỦA TÍNH TỪ ĐỐI VỚI DANH TỪ

adjective + noun

- | | | |
|--------|--|--------------------------------|
| ▪ Ex1: | It's a nice . | day today. |
| ▪ Ex2: | Laura has brown | eyes . |
| ▪ Ex3: | There's a very old | bridge in this village. |
| ▪ Ex4: | Do you like Italian | food ? |
| ▪ Ex5: | I don't speak any foreign | languages . |
| ▪ Ex6: | There are some beautiful yellow | flowers in the garden. |

The adjective is *before* the noun:

- Ex7: They live in a **modern house**. (*not* a house modern)
- Ex8: Have you met any **famous people**? (*not* people famous)

The ending of an adjective is always the same:

a **different place**

different places (*not* different)

Old / nice / interesting etc. (adjectives)

B VỊ TRÍ CỦA TÍNH TỪ ĐỐI VỚI ĐỘNG TỪ “TO BE”

be (am/is/was etc.) + adjective

- Ex9: The weather **is nice** today.
- Ex10: These flowers **are very beautiful**.
- Ex11: **Are you cold?** Shall I close the window?
- Ex12: I'm **hungry**. Can I have something to eat?
- Ex13: The film **wasn't very good**. It **was boring**.
- Ex14: Please **be quiet**. I'm reading.



Old / nice / interesting etc. (adjectives)

C VỊ TRÍ CỦA TÍNH TỪ “LOOK / FEEL / SMELL / TASTE / SOUND”



- Ex15: A: You **look** tired.
B: Yes, I **feel** tired.
- Ex16: Joe told me about his new job. It **sounds** very **interesting**.
- Ex17: I'm not going to eat this fish. It doesn't **smell** good

Compare:

He	is	
	feels	tired.
	looks	

They	are	
	look	happy.
	sound	

It	is	
	smells	good.
	tastes	

get + adjective (get hungry /tired etc.) → Unit 56
