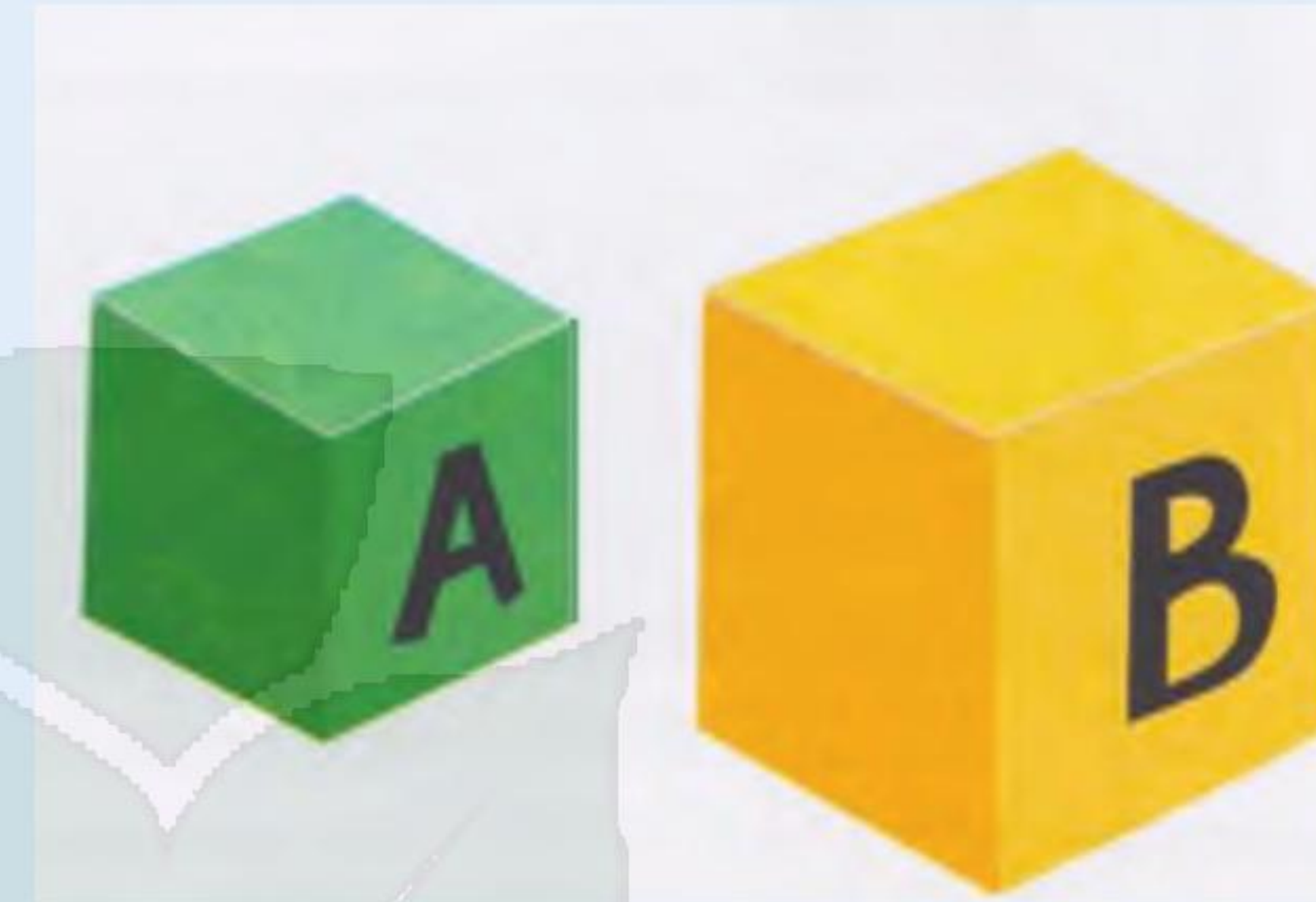
Not as ... as

A

CÁCH DÙNG “NOT AS ...AS”



She's old, but she's **not as old as** he is.



Box A **isn't as big as** Box B.

- Ex1: Rome **is not as old as** Athens.
(= Athens is **older**)
- Ex2: The Grand Hotel **isn't as expensive as** the Europa.
(= the Europa is **more expensive**)
- Ex3: I don't play tennis **as often as** you.
(= you play **more often**)
- Ex4: The weather is better than it was yesterday. It **isn't as cold**.
(= **as cold as it was yesterday**)

Not as ... as

B CÁCH DÙNG “NOT AS MUCH AS.../ NOT AS MANY AS...”

not as much as ... / not as many as ..

- Ex5: I don't have **as much money** as you. (= you've got **more money**)
- Ex6: I don't know **as many people** as you. (= you know **more people**)
- Ex7: I don't go out **as much** as you. (= you go out **more**)

Not as ... as

C SO SÁNH “NOT AS...” VÀ “THAN”

Compare **not as ... as** and **than**:

- Ex8: Rome is **not as old as** Athens.
- Ex9: Athens is **older than** Rome. (*not older as Rome*)
- Ex10: Tennis **isn't as popular as** football.
- Ex11: Football is **more popular than** tennis.
- Ex12: I **don't go out as much as** you.
- Ex13: You go out **more than** me

Not as ... as

D CÁCH DÙNG ĐẠI TỪ SAU “AS”

We usually say: as **me** / as **him** / as **her** etc.

You can say:

- Ex14: She's not as old as **him**. or She's not as old as **he is**.
- Ex15: You don't work as hard as **me**. or You don't work as hard as **I do**.

Not as ... as

E CÁCH DÙNG “THE SAME AS...”

We say **the same as...**:

- Ex16: The weather today is **the same as** yesterday.
- Ex17: My hair is **the same color as** yours.
- Ex18: I arrived at **the same time as** Tom.
