too ... for somebody/something

too ... to do something

too ... for somebody to do something

- Ex16: These shoes are **too big for me**.
- Ex17: It's a small house - **too small for a large family**.
- Ex18: I'm **too tired to go** out. (not for go out)
- Ex19: It's **too cold to sit** outside.
- Ex20: She speaks **too fast for me to understand**.

GIỚI THIỆU “TOO”



His shoes are **too big** for him.



There is **too much** sugar in it.

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Too

B “TOO” VỚI TÍNH TỪ VÀ TRẠNG TỪ

too + *adjective / adverb* (**too big / too hard** etc.)

- Ex1: Can you turn the radio down?

Its **too loud**. (= louder than I want)

- Ex2: I can't work. I'm **too tired**.
- Ex3: I think you work **too hard**.

C CÁCH DÙNG “TOO MUCH” VÀ “TOO MANY”

too much / too many = more than you want, more than is good:

- Ex4: I don't like the weather here. There is **too much rain**. (= more rain than is good)
- Ex5: Let's go to another restaurant. There are **too many people** here.
- Ex6: Emily studies all the time. I think she studies **too much**.
- Ex7: Traffic is a problem in this town. There are **too many cars**.

D SO SÁNH “TOO” VÀ “ENOUGH”



too big

- Ex8: The hat is **too big** for him.
- Ex9: The music is **too loud**. Can you turn it down, please?
- Ex10: There's **too much sugar** in my coffee.
(= more sugar than I want)
- Ex11: I don't feel very well. I ate **too much**.



not big enough

- Ex12: The hat **isn't big enough** for him. (= it's **too small**)
- Ex13: The music **isn't loud enough**. Can you turn it up, please?
- Ex14: There's **not enough sugar** in my coffee.
(= I need more sugar)
- Ex15: You're very thin. You **don't eat enough**.
