Always / usually / often

C TRẠNG TỪ ĐỨNG GIỮA TRỢ ĐỘNG TỪ VÀ ĐỘNG TỪ THƯỜNG

Always/never etc. go between two verbs (**have ... been / can ... find** etc.):

verb 1		verb 2
will can do etc	always often never etc.	go find remember etc.
have has		gone been etc.

EX14: I **will always** remember you.

EX15: It **doesn't often** rain here.

EX16: **Do you usually go** to work by car?

EX17: I **can never** find my keys.

EX18: **Have you ever been** to Egypt?

EX19: A: Where's Laura?

B: She's **just gone** out. (She's = She has)

EX20: My friends **have all gone** to the cinema.

always / never + present simple → **Unit 5**
all → **Units 80-81**

just / already + present perfect → **Unit 16**
both → **Units 82**

still → **Units 95**

Always / usually / often

TRẠNG TỪ Ở GIỮA CÂU

These words (**always/never** etc.) go with the verb in the middle of a sentence:

always	often	ever	rarely	also	already	all
usually	sometimes	never	seldom	just	still	both

EX1: My brother **never speaks** to me.

EX2: She's **always** late.

EX3: Do you **often go** to restaurants?

EX4: I **sometimes eat** too much. (or **Sometimes** I eat too much.)

EX5: A: Don't forget to phone Laura.

B: I've **already phoned** her.

EX6: I've got three sisters. They're **all** married.

Always / usually / often

B TRẠNG TỪ Ở GIỮA CÂU, TRƯỚC ĐỘNG TỪ THƯỜNG

Always/never etc. go before the verb:

	verb
always	go
often	play
never	have
etc.	etc.

EX7: I **always drink** coffee in the morning.
(not I drink always coffee)

EX8: Helen **often goes** to London.
(not Helen goes often)

EX9: You **sometimes look** unhappy.

EX10: They **usually have** dinner at 7 o'clock.

EX11: We **rarely watch** TV. or
We **seldom watch** TV.

EX12: Richard is a good footballer. He **also plays** tennis and volleyball.
(not He plays also tennis)

EX13: I've got three sisters. They **all live** in London.
