After these verbs (give/lend etc.); there are


two possible structures:

give something to somebody

Ex1: I gave the keys to Sarah.

give somebody something

Ex2: I gave Sarah the keys.

			something	<b>to</b> somebody
Ex3:	That's my book.	Give	it	to me.
• Ex4:	These are Sue's keys. Can you	give	them	to her?
Ex5:	Can you	give	these flowers	to your mother?
Ex6:		lent	my car	to a friend of mine.
Ex7:	Did you	send	the money	to Kate?
• Ex8:	We've seen these photos. You	showed	them	to us.

## CÂU TRÚC "GIVE SOMEBODY SOMETHING"

			somebody	something
■ Ex9:		Give	me	that book. It's mine.
Ex10:	Tom	gave	his mother	some flowers.
■ Ex11:		lent	Joe	some money.
■ Ex12:	How much money did you	lend	him?	
■ Ex13:		sent	you	an email. Did you get it?
■ Ex14:	Nicola	showed	dus	her holiday photos
Ex15:	Can you	pass	me	the salt, please?

You can also say buy /get somebody something':

- Ex16: I bought my mother some flowers. (= I bought some flowers for my mother.)
- Ex17: I'm going to the shop. Can I get you anything? (= get anything for you)

#### D LƯU Ý

#### You can say:

- Ex18: I gave the keys to Sarah.
  and I gave Sarah the keys.
  (but not I gave to Sarah the keys)
- Ex19: That's my book. Can you give it to me? and Can you give me that book? (but not Can you give to me that book?)

We prefer the first structure (give something to somebody) with it or them:

- Ex20: I gave it to her. (not I gave her it)
- Ex21: Here are the keys. Give them to your father, (not Give your father them)
