








A CÂU ĐIỀU KIỆN LOẠI 2

Dan likes fast cars, but he doesn't have one. He doesn't have enough money.

If he had the money, he would buy a fast car.

Usually had is past, but in this sentence had is not past. If he had the money = if he had the money now (but he doesn't have it)

A CÂU ĐIỀU KIỆN LOẠI 2

You can say:

Ex1: If he had the money, he would buy a car.
or He would buy a car if he had the money.

I'd / she'd / they'd etc. = I would / she would / they would etc.:

- Ex2: I don't know the answer. If I knew the answer, I'd tell you.
- Ex3: It's raining, so we're not going out. We'd get wet if we went out.
- Ex4: Jane lives in a city. She likes cities. She wouldn't be happy if she lived in the country.
- Ex5: If you didn't have a job, what would you do? (but you have a job)
- Ex6: I'm sorry I can't help you. I'd help you if I could, (but I can't)
- Ex7: If we had a car, we could travel more, (but we don't have a car, so we can't travel much)

"WAS / WERE" TRONG MỆNH ĐỀ IF

If (I) was/were ...

You can say: **if** l/he/she/it **was** or **if** l/he/she/it **were**

Ex8: It's not a very nice place. I wouldn't go there if I were you.
 (or ... if I was you)

Ex9: It would be nice if the weather was better.
 (or ... if the weather were better)

■ Ex10: What would Tom do if he were here?

(or ... if he was here)





SO SÁNH CÂU ĐIỀU KIỆN LOẠI 1 VÀ LOẠI 2

Compare:

if I have / if it is etc.

- Ex11A: I must go and see Helen.
 If I have time, I will go today.
 (= maybe I'll have time, so maybe I'll go)
- Ex12A: I like that jacket.
 I'll buy it if it isn't too expensive.
 (= maybe it will not be too expensive)
- Ex13A: I'll help you if I can. (= maybe I can)

if I had / if it was etc.

- Ex11B: I must go and see Helen.
 If I had time, I would go today.
 (= I don't have time today, so I will not go)
- Ex12B: I like this jacket, but it's very expensive.
 I'd buy it if it wasn't so expensive.
 (= it is expensive, so I'm not going to buy it)
- Ex13B: I'd help you if I could, but I can't.
