A GIỚI TỪ CHỈ THỜI GIAN “AT, ON, IN”

at



at	8 o'clock 10.30 midnight etc.
-----------	-------------------------------------

- Ex1: I start work **at 8 o'clock**.
- Ex2: The shops close **at 5.30**.

on



on	Sunday(s) / Monday(s) etc. 25 April / 6 June etc. New Year's Day etc.
-----------	---

- Ex3: Bye! I'll see you **on Friday**.
- Ex4: What do you usually do **on Sundays**?
- Ex5: The concert is **on 22 November**.

in



in	April/June etc. 2013/1988 etc. summer/spring etc.
-----------	---

- Ex6: I'm going on holiday **in October**.
- Ex7: Emma was born **in 1995**.
- Ex8: The park is beautiful **in spring**.

At 8 oclock – on Monday – in April



B GIỚI TỪ “AT”

We say:

at the weekend
at night
at Christmas
at the end of ...
at the moment

- Ex9: Are you going away **at the weekend**?
- Ex10: I can't sleep **at night**.
- Ex11: Where will you be **at Christmas**? (*but on Christmas Day*)
- Ex12: I'm going on holiday **at the end of** October.
- Ex13: Are you busy **at the moment**?

At 8 oclock – on Monday – in April

C GIỚI TỪ “IN”

in the morning / in the afternoon / in the evening

- Ex14: I always feel good **in the morning**.
- Ex15: Do you often go out **in the evening**?

but

on Monday morning / on Tuesday afternoon / on Friday evening / on Saturday night etc:

- Ex16: I'm meeting Jackie **on Monday morning**.
- Ex17: Are you doing anything **on Saturday night**?

At 8 oclock – on Monday – in April

D CÁC TRƯỜNG HỢP KHÔNG DÙNG “AT / ON / IN”

We do not use **at/on/in** before:

this ... (this morning / this week etc.)

last ... (last August / last week etc.)

next ... (next Monday / next week etc.)

every ... (every day / every week etc.)

- Ex18: Are you going out **this evening**?
- Ex19: We go on holiday **every summer**. **Last summer** we went to Canada.
- Ex20: I'm leaving **next Monday**. (*not on next Monday*)

At 8 oclock – on Monday – in April

E “IN” DÙNG VỚI KHOẢNG THỜI GIAN

in five minutes / in a few days / in six weeks / in two years etc.



now

in five
minutes

- Ex21: Hurry! The train leaves **in five minutes**.
(= it leaves five minutes from now)
- Ex22: Bye! I'll see you **in a few days**.
(= a few days from now)

in / on / at (places) → Unit 106–107
