EX10: 'Where's Kate?' 'She's at work.'

EX11: Helen is studying law at university.

EX12: I'll meet you at the station, OK?

EX13: A: Where were you yesterday?

B: At my sister's.

EX14: I saw Tom at the doctor's.

EX15: There weren't many people at the party.


Often it is possible to use in or at for buildings (hotels, restaurants etc.):
