








A GIỚI TỪ CHỈ NƠI CHỐN " TO, IN, AT"

to

go/come/return/walk (etc) to...



EX1: We're going to London on Sunday.

EX2: I want to go to Italy next year.

EX3: We walked from my house to the center of

town.

EX4: What time do you go to bed?

in/at (→Unit 106-107)

be/stay/do something (etc) in...



EX9: Piccadilly Circus is in London.

EX10: My brother lives in Italy.

EX11: The main shops are in the center of town.

EX12: I like reading in bed.

EX5: The bus is going to the airport.

EX6: Karen didn't go to work yesterday.

EX7: I went to a party last night.

EX8: You must come to our house.

be/stay/do something (etc.) at...



EX13: The bus is at the airport.

EX14: Sarah wasn't at work yesterday.

EX15: I met a lot of people at the party.

EX16: Helen stayed at her brother's house.



B GIỚI TỪ VỚI TỪ "HOME"

go/come/walk (etc) home (without to):

EX17: I'm tired. I'm going home.

(not to home)

EX18: Did you walk home?

be/stay/do something (etc.) at home:

EX19: I'm staying at home tonight.

EX20: Dan doesn't work in an office.

He works at home.



GIỚI TỪ VỚI ĐỘNG TỪ "ARRIVE" VÀ "GET"

arrive in a country or town (arrive in Italy / arrive in Paris etc.):

- EX21: They arrived in this country last week. (not arrived to this country)
- arrive at other places (arrive at the station / arrive at work etc.):
- EX22: What time did you arrive at the hotel? (not arrive to the hotel)
- get to (a place):
- EX23: What time did you get to the hotel?
- EX24: What time did you get to Paris?
- get home / arrive home (no preposition).
- EX25: I was tired when I got home, or I was tired when I arrived home.
