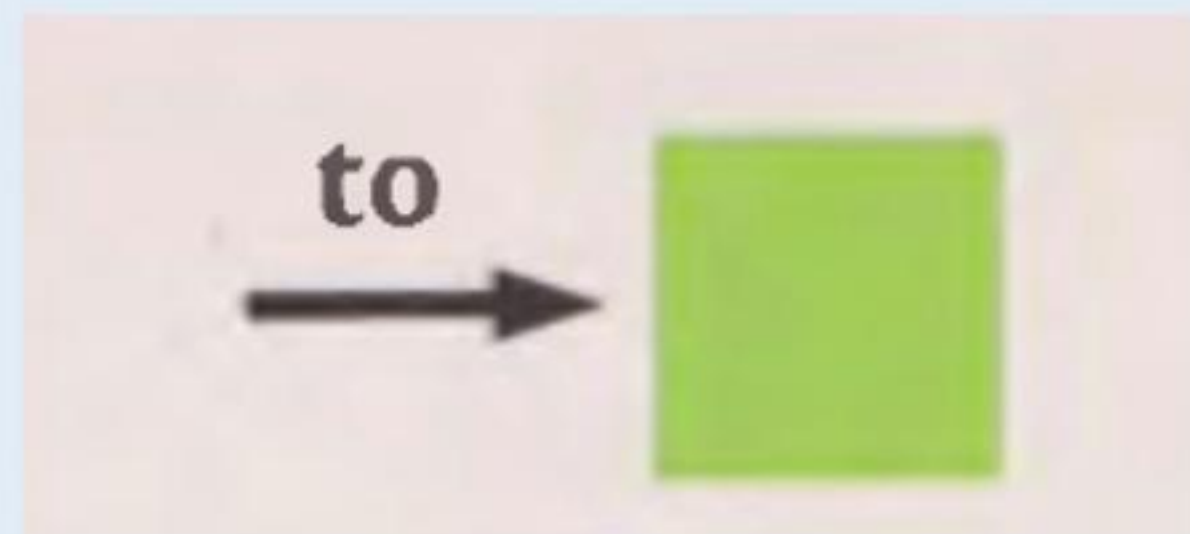

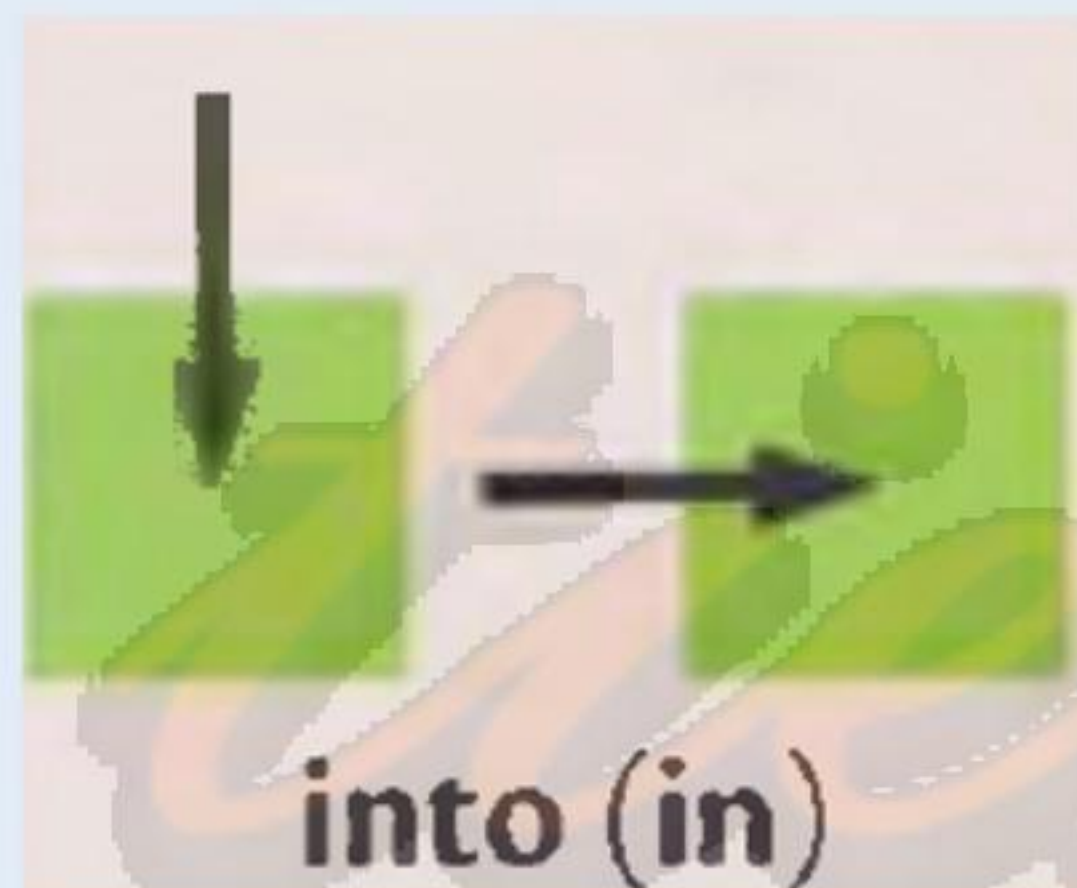
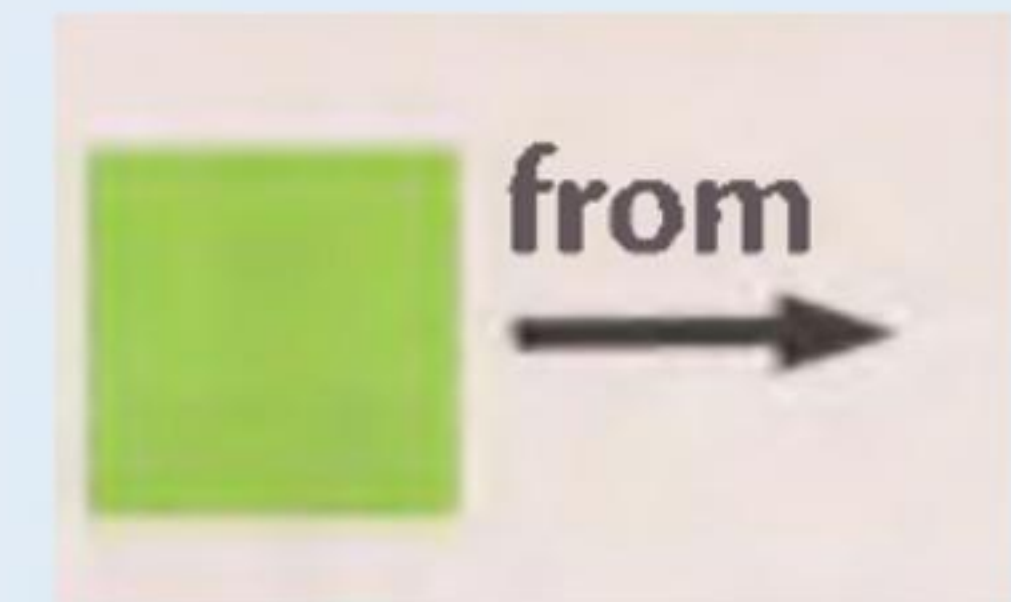
## A TO AND FROM / INTO AND OUT OF



EX1: Jane is going **to** France next week.

EX2: We walked **from** the hotel **to** the station.

EX3: A lot of English words come **from** Latin.

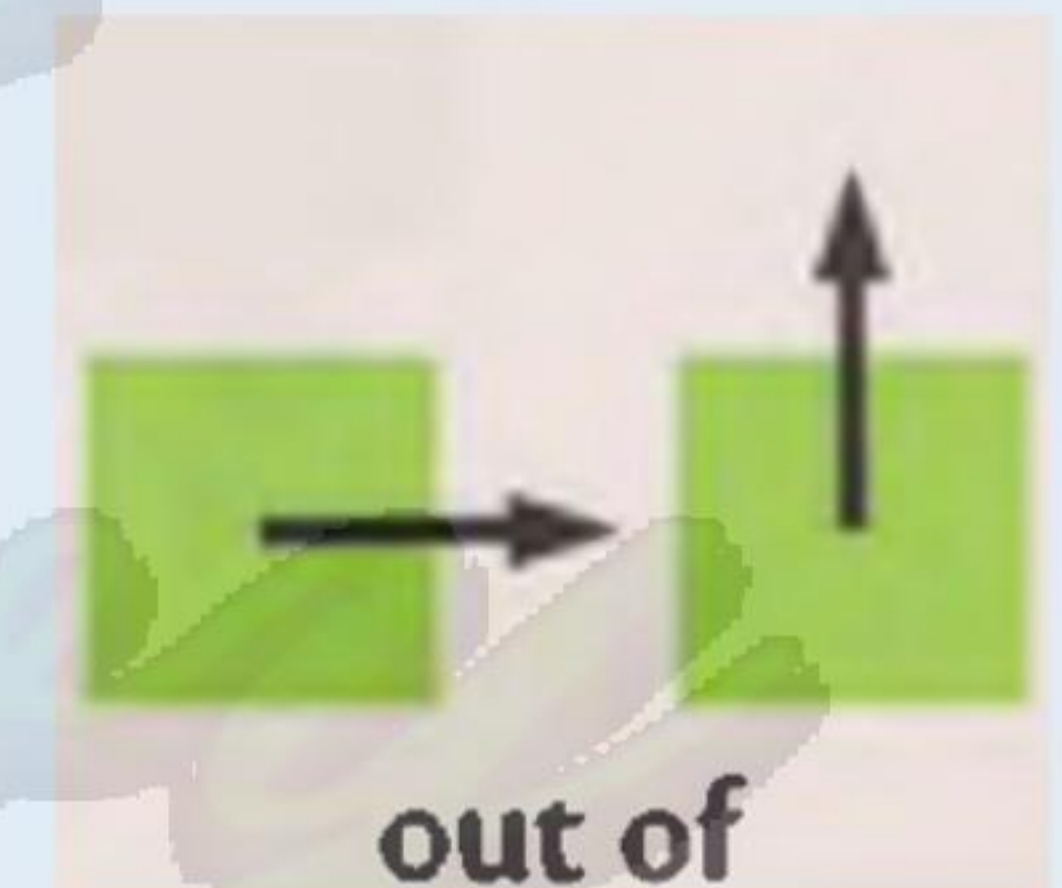


EX4: We jumped **into** the water.

EX5: A man came out of the house and got **into** a car.

EX6: Why are you looking **out of** the window?

EX7: I took the old batteries out of the radio.



We say **put** something **in** ... (not usually into):

EX8: I **put** new batteries **in** the radio.

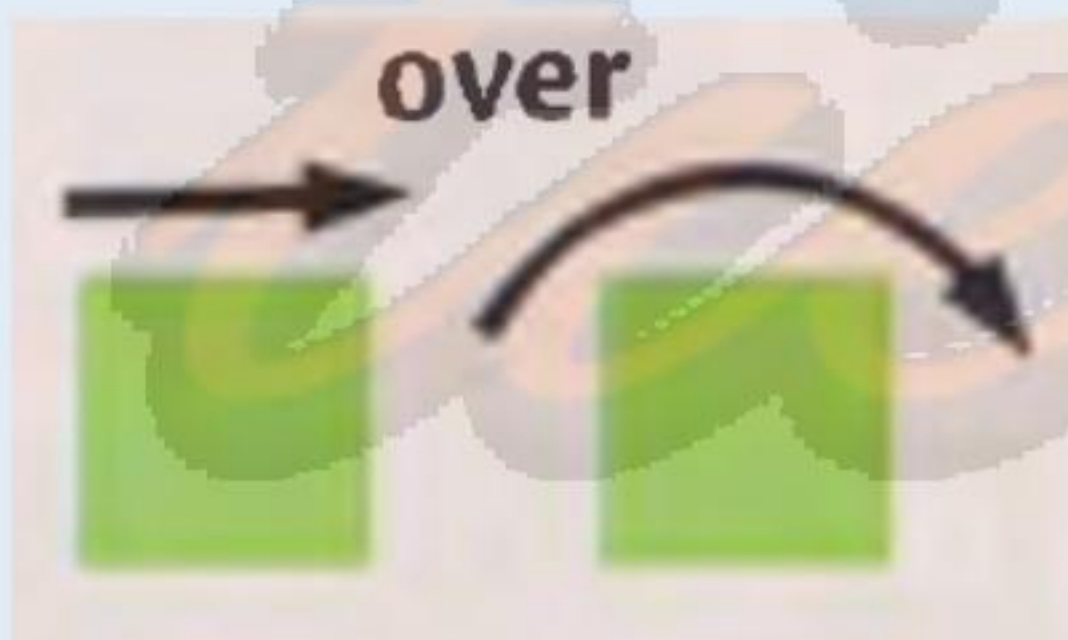
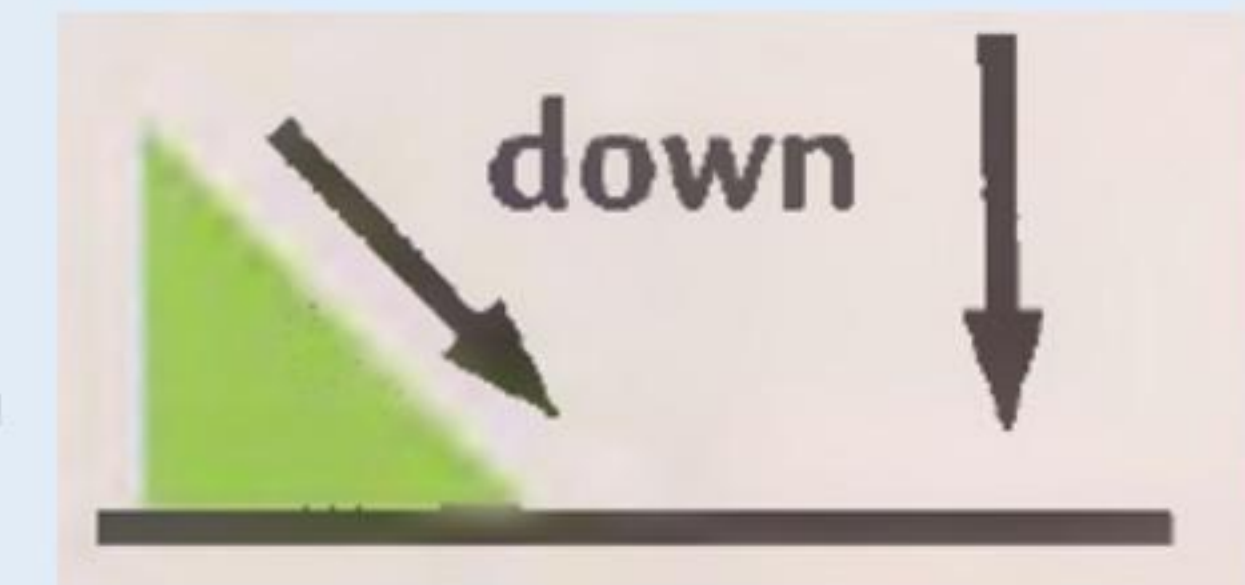
## B ON AND OFF / UP AND DOWN / OVER AND UNDER



- EX9: Don't put your feet **on** the table.
- EX10: Please take your feet **off** the table.
- EX11: I'm going to hang some pictures **on** the wall.
- EX12: Be careful! Don't fall **off** your bike.
- EX13: We got **on** the bus in Princes Street.



- EX14: We walked **up** the hill to the house.
- EX15: Be careful! Don't fall **down** the stairs.



- EX16: The plane flew **over** the mountains.
- EX17: I jumped **over** the wall into the garden.
- EX18: Some people say it is unlucky to walk **under** a ladder.

## C THROUGH AND AROUND / ALONG AND ACROSS

EX19: A bird flew into the room **through** a window.

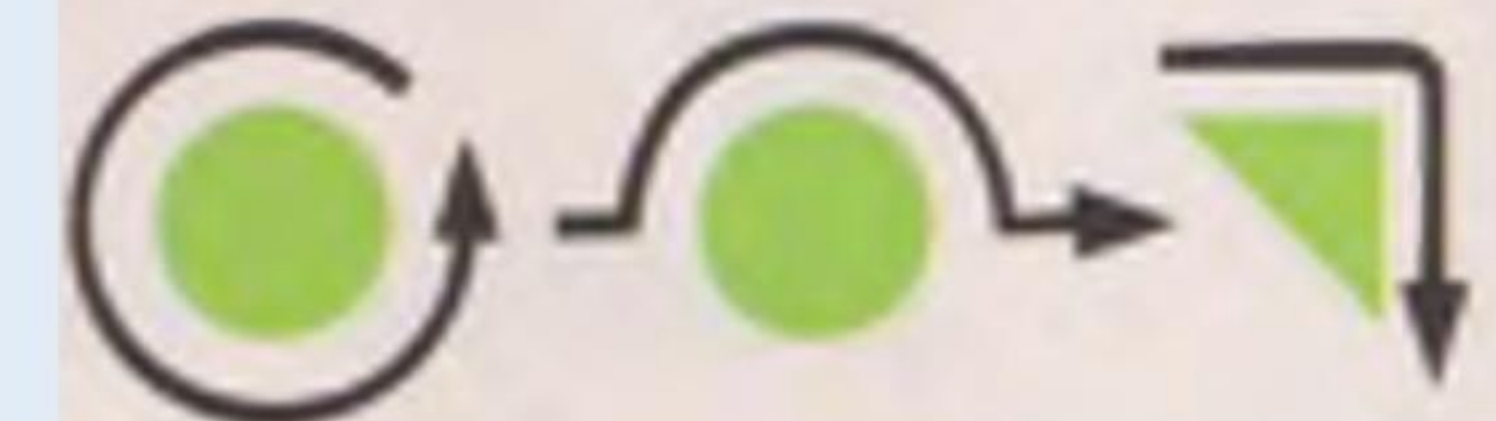
EX20: The old road goes **through** the village.

EX21: The new road goes **round** the village.

EX22: The bus stop is just **round** the corner.

EX23: I walked **round** the town and took some photographs.

round



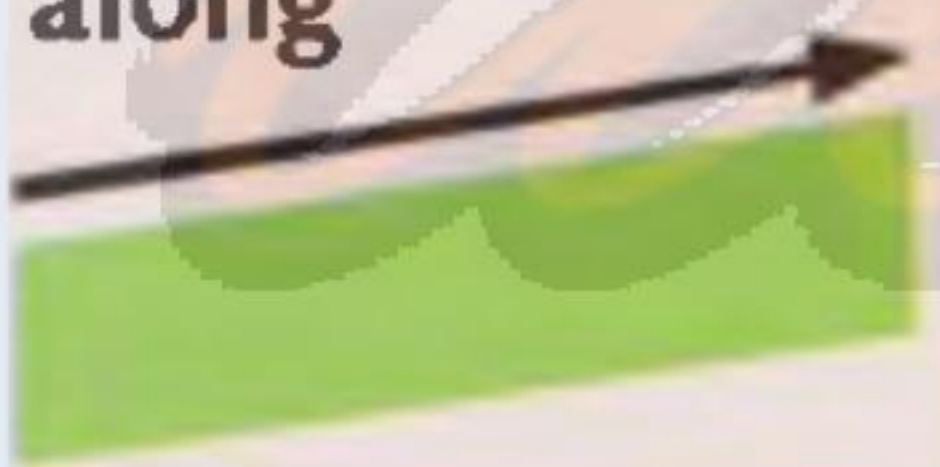
You can also use **around** (= round):

EX24: We walked **around** the town.



round the town

along



EX25: I was walking **along** the road with my dog.

EX26: Let's go for a walk **along** the river.

EX27: The dog swam **across** the river.

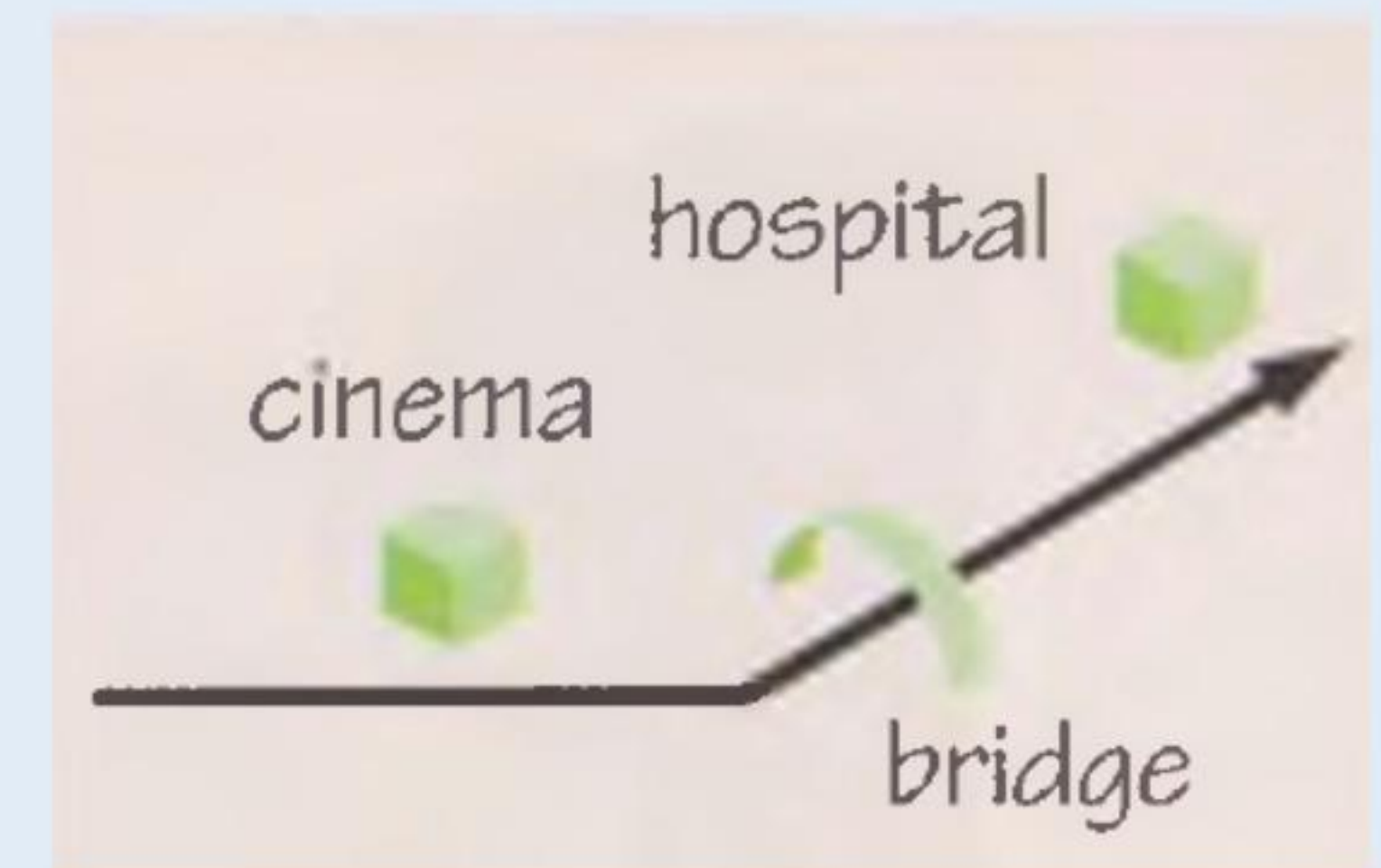
PAST



EX28: They walked **past** me without speaking.

EX29: A: Excuse me, how do I get to the hospital?

B: Go along this road, **past** the cinema, under the bridge and the hospital is on the left.
