ON

on holiday	EX1:	Jane isn't at work this week. She's on holiday.
on television	EX2:	We watched the news on TV.
on the radio	EX3:	We listened to the news on the radio.
on the phone	EX4:	I spoke to Rachel on the phone last night.
on fire	EX5:	The house is on fire! Call the fire brigade.
on time (= not late)	EX6:	'Was the train late?' 'No, it was on time.'

AT

at (the age of) 21 / at 50 kilometers an hour / at 100 degrees etc.:

- EX7: Lisa got married at 21. (or... at the age of 21.)
- EX8: A car uses more petrol at 120 kilometers an hour than at 90.
- EX9: Water boils at 100 degrees Celsius.



C BY

by car / by bus / by plane / by bike etc.:

- EX10: Do you like travelling by train?
- EX11: Jane usually goes to work by bike.


but on foot:

EX12: You can't get there by car. You have to go on foot.
(= you have to walk)



a book by ... / a painting by ... / a piece of music by... etc.:

- EX13: Have you read any books by Charles Dickens?
- EX14: Who is that painting by? Picasso?



by after the passive (—> Unit 21):

EX15: I was bitten by a dog.


WITH / WITHOUT

- EX19: I cut the paper with a pair of scissors.

- EX20: Do you know that man with the beard?
- EX21: I'd like to have a house with a big garden.

- EX22: Some people talk about their work all the time.
- EX23: I don't know much about cars.

EX24: There was a program about volcanoes on TV last night. Did you see it?
