





Unit 114 – Go in, fall off, run away etc. (phrasal verb 1)



A GO IN AND GO OUT / GOT IN AND GOT OUT

A phrasal verb is a verb (go/look/be etc.) + in/out/up/down etc



EX1: I waited outside the shop. I didn't go in.

EX2: Sarah opened the door of the car and got

in. (= into the car)



EX3: I went to the window and looked out.

EX4: The car stopped and a woman got out.


(= out of the car)

GOT ON / FALL OFF



C STAND UP / SIT DOWN



EX7: He stood up and left the room.

EX8: I usually get up early. (= get out of bed)

EX9: We looked up at the stars in the sky.



EX10: The picture fell down.

EX11: Would you like to sit down?

EX12: Lie down on the floor.

RUN AWAY / COME BACK




EX13: The thief ran away. (or ... ran off)

EX14: Emma got into the car and drove away.

(or ... drove off)

be/go away (= in/to another place)

EX15: Tom has gone away for a few days.



EX16: Go away and don't come back!

EX17: We went out for dinner and then went

back to our hotel.

be back

EX18: Tom is away. He'll be back on Monday.


CLIMB OVER / TURNED AROUND



EX19: The wall wasn't very high, so we

climbed over.

EX20: Turn over and look at the next page.



EX21: Somebody shouted my name, so I

looked round (or around).

EX22: We went for a long walk. After an hour

we turned round (or around) and went back.
